Upcoming Events:

<u>Little David (Special Event Station W4D)</u> event on **7 Oct 23** will be our fall operating day. TW Kirkpatrick KF4CQH, has been given permission for the club's use of the lineman training area. Santee Cooper is making some modifications the field. The gate on Stoney Landing Rd, Moncks Corner will be open; same as last year. Operating time will be 10 AM to about 3 PM. Ron K4TCP has contacted ARRL to advertise the SES and we have the W4D callsign for the event. Update: Verbal permission has been received to use the field.

The first MHRS Training Day will be **7 Oct 23** at 9 AM at the Little David SES site to cover setup, use of the new radios, take down and securing the trailer. This training will be done with groups of 3 to 4 club members to ensure each person is familiar with all the systems that have been installed. As folks complete the training, they will receive a card indicating areas they are trained in.

<u>Boy Scouts of America JOTA</u> is **21 Oct 23**The event provides an opportunity to demonstrate ham radio to Sea Scout Ship #1 in Charleston. This event will be at BSA Camp Moultrie, 148 Boy Scout Ln, Moncks Corner, SC 29461. We will need folks to man the MHRS. John Atkinson, K4ODA, asked if we could support his troop with VHF radio contacts, which we will do. Update: Jim Self KW4PW will be there at 9 AM.

<u>Alternative sites</u> for winter field day and summer field day. In the past the club had gone to state parks for 'field day' type events. Jim Self KW4PW will gather additional information for the next board meeting.

The visit to Trident Tech will be in the spring (**Feb or Mar 2024**). They are planning to have us for an Electrical/ Electronics Engineering Department event. Moving forward the club will focus on STEM events and school events for use of the MHRS.

Trailer Update:

The trailer group is still waiting for remaining parts (aka contest console) of the intercom system to arrive, install of computers and monitors to allow loggers and operators to hear each other through their respective headsets.

The intercom (aka contest console) is one unit that goes inline of the radio pro and user pro units. Steve has received the prototype unit and will be testing it out soon. The production units should be ready for order in November cost is \$200 plus shipping. He will have the console to show off at the meeting.

As the trailer is put in service a list of improvements or additions will be requested from those operating from the MHRS.
