Old Business:

Trailer Maintenance and Deployment Committee: POC Steve KO4AFL

Members: Chip WB4ZVR, Jim KW4PW, Mike KJ4TAC, Ron K4TCP and Glenn WA4NMW

- Club, educational and promotional use.
- Request for trailer use to be submitted to the committee 60-90 days in advance.
- Work left to be done:
 - Mount propane tanks after continued floor repair (weld frame "C" channel support)
 - TW suggested we mount the two tanks on the tongue and buy a cover for them. Steve advised against having that much weight on the tongue.
 - \circ $\,$ Some rust spots noted on the trailer frame and needs to be removed
 - Small dehumidifier for the trailer: The membership approved \$350 for a dehumidifier. Consider providing Glenn a stipend to use his outdoor outlet.
 - GPS repeater \$80 approved: Need to mount antenna on the roof upright.
 - Solar panels and charge controller have been mounted. Need to run conduit through the roof and into the trailer electrical system.
 - Soundproof curtain obtained and needs to be installed.

Education and Scholarship Committee: Jim KO4MNB and Stephen K4OPZ

<u>Palmetto Scholars Academy</u> POC Steve K4OPZ – PSA has a new principal, a new vice principal and many new teachers. Requested Ricky Reyes, new vice principal, to meet to discuss the K4PSA equipment and location, but we have had no response. The site needs a teacher to run the club.

St. John Catholic School: POC Jim KO4MNB and Stephen K4OPZ

- The HF/VHF/UHF radios are fully operational. Great work by the TARC team!
- Principal Karen Durand, KQ4TVY, who joined our meeting tonight, asked TARC to teach electronics starting in <u>January 2025</u>. TARC team proposed a flashing LED multi-vibrator circuit kit for the students to build. Additionally, Durand requests TARC team to teach soldering to the 7th and 8th graders so their kit will include printed circuit boards. The 5th and 6th graders would not be soldering, but use push pin press boards. <u>We need at least four volunteers to be team leaders to mentor the students.</u> Contact Jim KO4MNB to volunteer.

SC Department of Employment and Workforce (SCDEW): POC Jim Wasson, KO4MNB

TARC and the South Carolina Department of Employment and Workforce (SCDEW) was selected to participate in a scheduled Amateur Radio on the International Space Station (ARISS) contact.

The four schools that are vying for the ISS contact are as follows:

- Woodland Middle School in Dorchester
- Ronald McNair School in Lake City
- Hillcrest Middle School in Dalzell
- Lake Marion Middle School

Steve K4OPZ and Jim KO4MNB developed Virtual Training Lessons with six pre-recorded audio-visual presentations. The six narrated PPT files are posted on the SCDEW Dropbox.

The presentation dates are 2-6 September (done), 16-20 September (done) and <u>7-11</u> <u>October</u>. Each school will do their own hands-on activities to augment the lesson plans.

35 teams of students prepared 235 questions to ask the astronauts during the ISS contact. TARC will select the 20 best questions to be asked. Scoring sheets are due to Jim KO4MNB no later than <u>28 October</u> to send a compilation to SCDEW, ARISS and NASA by <u>31 October</u>.

The <u>first week of November</u>, will be the selection of the host school for the contact and selection of those students who will be asking questions to the astronauts <u>the first week of</u> <u>December</u>. We expect a turnout of 400-500 people with TV News crews to attend.

The Board approved taking the TARC Trailer to the event for PR purposes. Jim KO4MNB offered to tow the trailer with his GMC Yukon, once he is trained by the trailer committee.

A recommendation was made to submit a write up for QST magazine. Jim KO4MNB volunteered.

NEW BUSINESS:

TREASURER: Jim KW4PW Discuss plan for future use of club finances.

<u>Education Committee</u>: The Board discussed providing philanthropy support to St. John School for their 2025 hands-on electronics project. Last school year, we relied on member donations to purchase the crystal radio kits and transistor amplifier kits. For this school year, an estimate was provided of approximately \$173 for 25 flashing LED kits and \$270 for 6 soldering stations (30W soldering irons, cage, tools, third-hand stand and safety glasses), plus taxes and shipping. A motion was made, seconded and passed as follows:

Subject to final approval by the membership, the Board recommends to appropriate approximately \$500 to purchase the materials and tools for the St. John School 2025 student electronics project. The club will take ownership of the soldering station equipment. Update: members approved up to \$525 to support the St John School program for soldering kits and push boards. Hams are needed to work with the students. Approximately 12 hands were raised to support hands on learning.

<u>Scholarship Program</u>: POC: Owen Trott, KF5BLK, reported that Tom Lufkin had terminated his W4DAX scholarship. There was a discussion on how to continue this program and how to fund it. Owen suggested we have an online application instead of a paper form, and we launch an advertising and promotional campaign. He will be sending out letters to various Government agencies to obtain feedback and will talk to school superintendents. A motion was made, seconded and passed as follows:

Owen KF5BLK will present his proposal regarding an overhauled TARC Scholarship Program to the Board at the <u>6 January 2025</u> meeting. The proposal will address how to obtain interest within tri-county high schools in applying for the scholarship and fundraising activities to fund the program for the 2025-2026 school year.

A member noted it might be better to invest in the school programs rather than the scholarship program.

<u>TARC Banner</u>: There was a brief discussion about purchasing a TARC Banner that can be displayed at events where we set up a ham radio station without the trailer, such as at the Citadel, so as to have some visibility to aid in recruitment. The banner we had previously was old and tattered, and thus it was discarded. Vista Print sells vinyl 2.5' x 4' vinyl banners with grommets for \$39.99 plus tax and shipping. The decision was tabled.

Update: Club approved up to \$100 to be used to purchase a banner. The Board will make final decisions.
