Vatican report. While visiting Rome for the funeral of Pope Francis, Jim Wasson, KO4MNB, arranged for a June 5 contact with the Vatican Amateur Radio Station HV4NAC. Jim had to make the FT-8 contact from home due to technical issues with the station at Saint John Catholic School. When the Vatican called CQ, there was an immediate pile up (of course) on 21.047MHz so they switched to 21.077MHz to make the contact. Then the operator, Luciano IOJBL, called CQ to make the contact with Jim from HV4NAC. The antenna system on top of the Pontifical North American College includes a steppIR horizontal,

HF vertical and several other beam antennas. Their QSL card shows the Vatican station with Saint Peter's Basilica in the background.
